POOL FACILITY INFORMATION & RULES

We hope the following information regarding the oceanfront Beach Club pool is helpful to you. To ensure that your visit is both enjoyable & safe, we appreciate your attention to the following:

POOL INFO & ADMISSION: Guest <u>introduction cards</u> are issued by the rental agencies and are required for admission to the pool facilities. Membership cards and weekly guest passes are then issued at the facilities on your initial visit. Members and guests must show their cards and sign in at the facility office on each visit to the pool. Pools are open from 9:00am to 8:00pm during the in—seasons (June—August) weather permitting. Several recreational activities are also available for daily use including corn hole, ping pong, and pool table.

PINE ISLAND BEACH CLUB: The Beach Club/South pool complex is located at 351 Audubon Drive (just north of the Hampton Inn) and is a facility for the exclusive use of Pine Island Property Owners, their guests including renters, and associate members. Feel free to contact the staff at 252.453.9024.

POOL AREA:

- Management reserves the right to deny use of the pool to anyone at any time.
- Please shower before entering pool.
- For safety reasons, diving, running, rough play, "cannonballs" and unnecessary noise are not permitted at any time.
- Children under the age of 12 must have adult supervision at all times. Children will not be allowed in water over their shoulders unless accompanied by a responsible adult on a one on one basis or they can demonstrate their ability to swim the width of the pool and handle themselves well in deep water.
- Use of the wading pool is limited to children six years of age and under. Children using the wading pool must be attended by a responsible adult at all times. There will not be a lifeguard on duty at the wading pool.
- Non-toilet trained children must wear swim diapers or diapers and tight fitting plastic pants under their swim suits when using the pool. Swim diapers are available for purchase.
- Adults should not swim alone.
- Though lifeguards are on duty during scheduled shifts, SWIMMING IS ALWAYS AT YOUR OWN RISK. Owners and Management are not responsible for accidents or injuries.
- No pets are allowed in pool area.
- No glass containers are permitted in the pool area and deck areas at any time. Alcoholic beverages are also prohibited.
- Ball throwing, large floatation devices, tubes, rings and other aquatic play equipment are not permitted in the pool.
- Life preserver and safety rope must remain hung at all times, unless being used during an emergency. The pool may be considered out of compliance with local and state mandated rules when it is not, and may result in pool closure.
- Be aware of the pool emergency phone location, and note the pool addresses in the event that you need to call for emergency assistance.
